The **NCAGT James J. Gallagher Advocacy Award** is presented to an individual inside or outside the field of gifted education who has been a consistent advocate on behalf of gifted students and a voice for supporting gifted education in North Carolina. Formerly called the “Special Award,” this award was renamed in honor of Dr. James J. Gallagher in recognition of his continued role in advocating for gifted children, their teachers, and their parents. Nominations are made by the general membership and final selection is through a secret ballot by the NCAGT Board of Directors. This award is not presented each year and past recipients may not be nominated for this award again.
