



## 2023 NCAAGT Leadership through Service Award

**The Leadership through Service Award** was established by NCAAGT to recognize distinguished leadership through service by an AIG student enrolled in grades 7-12. The student named as the Leadership through Service Award recipient will receive a \$250 check and a NCAAGT Certificate of Excellence.

### Nomination Criteria

1. Students must be enrolled in grades 7 – 12 at the time of nomination.
2. Students must show outstanding distinguished leadership through service.
3. Students must be nominated by a current NCAAGT member.

### Application

The Digital Application can be found [here](#). This application asks for student information as well as the following in the form of **DIGITAL LINKS**:

1. Student Nominees must submit the following information in any format (essay, audio, video, etc):
  - a description of the service-related activity for which the student is being nominated
  - how the student got interested in the service activity
  - what inspiration the service activity has had on the student and on others
2. Student Nominees are encouraged to attach any relevant supporting materials such as newspaper clippings and/or photos that may further inform the selection committee.
3. Applications must include two recommendations from someone other than a nominee's family member, explaining why the student nominee is deserving of the award, what sets him or her apart from other students, and how the nominee is impacting others.

**These must be included as a DIGITAL LINK (Google Doc, OneDrive Doc, Audio, Video, etc.)  
Make sure the LINK is able to be opened by ANYONE with the link.**

***Nomination Form must be completed before midnight December 9, 2022.***
