



2024 NCAGT Student Scholarship

Purpose

Student Scholarships are intended to assist North Carolina's gifted students, K-12, to excel in an area of interest or achievement. Scholarship funds are awarded to help finance an original project which holds promise for the advancement of learning or contributes to some field of endeavor and/or an instructional opportunity not available within a student's local school district.

Awards

Individual scholarships will be awarded in amounts up to \$250.00. *Students are expected to provide follow-up reflection on their project by the end of May.*

Eligibility

Any grade K-12 student is eligible who currently qualifies as academically and/or intellectually gifted according to local guidelines and whose application is sponsored by a current member of NCAGT/PAGE.

Selection

Scholarships will be funded on a competitive basis. The NCAGT Scholarship Committee will evaluate each application, considering equally the merits of the proposal, a statement of anticipated or actual expenses, documentation of the student's commitment to and degree of interest in the project or opportunity, and letters of recommendation. NCAGT reserves the right to validate evidence submitted by any applicant. Each applicant will be notified if he or she has or has not been awarded a scholarship by February.

Application

The Digital Application can be found [here](#). This application asks for the following:

- applicant information
- a description of the nature and purpose of the project and/ or instructional opportunity
- a detailed budget statement showing proposed or actual expenses
- a Personal Statement of the applicant's commitment to purpose, including autobiographical statements regarding achievements and interest
- Two letters of recommendation or letters of support. One of these must come from the NCAGT/PAGE member sponsoring the applicant. Please address how the scholarship would be important in providing this student such an opportunity.

These must be included as a DIGITAL LINK (Google Doc, OneDrive Doc, Audio, Video, etc.) Make sure the LINK is able to be opened by ANYONE with the link.

Scholarship Application must be completed before midnight **December 15, 2023.**
